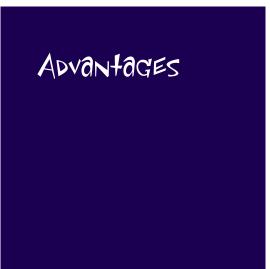
The big plus of social art projects is the involvement of third parties in the creation of a work of art for their immediate environment. Those involved can develop their own ideas into real self-made works of art. Resulting in:



A fun and fresh decoration of the environment with appropriate themes. Maintenance-friendly both indoors and outdoors, because the mosaic and/or the paintings are finished off with a coating against graffiti and weather influences. A limited investment with a high return in terms of appearance and enhancement of the environment. The functional aspect in combination with appealing art, which can be understood by everyone, will be appreciated by a wide audience.

# SCHOOL PROJECTS

#### School projects

School projects by Artista are suitable for both primary and secondary schools.

The big advantage of these projects is the involvement of the students and their teachers in the decoration of their daily environment, the school. We start from the needs and possibilities of the students and teachers.

The students discover and develop their own creativity, learn to work together, and learn to listen to each other's ideas and opinions.

The appreciation of their own work and 'prevention of vandalism', you do not ruin something you have created yourself, are of additional value.

From experience we know that especially children, once they have started, they do not want to stop, and they are able to turn their creative ideas into beautiful works of art!

After extensive instruction, Artista will supervise the project and takes care of all materials, including objects and the required tools. The final finishing touch will be provided by Artista as well.

Graffiti.

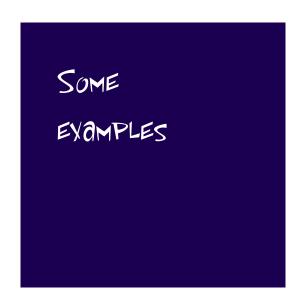
Pixel paintings (1 image consisting of small individually painted canvases).

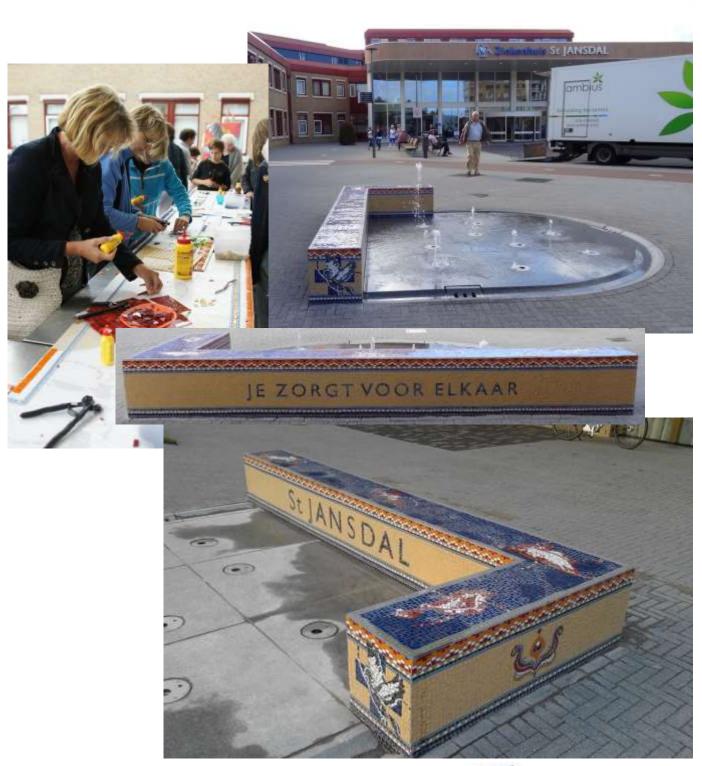
